

## General Provisions

1. The general conditions contained in the present legal notice regulate the access and use of the Site which Cygnus makes available to internet users free of charge. Access to it implies acceptance without reservation. The use of certain services offered on the Site will be governed, in addition, by the particular conditions provided in each case, which will be understood and accepted by the mere use of such services.
2. The display, printing and partial downloading of the content of the Site is authorised only and exclusively if the following conditions are complied with:
  - That it is compatible with the purposes of the Site.
  - That it is done with the exclusive aim of obtaining the information contained for personal and private use. It is expressly forbidden to use it for commercial purposes or for its distribution, public communication, transformation or decomposition.
  - That none of the contents of the Site are modified in any way.
  - That no graphic, icon or image available on the Site be used, copied or distributed separately from the rest of the images that accompany it.
3. Cygnus reserves the right to make changes and updates to the information contained in the Site, the configuration and presentation of the Site and the conditions of access, at any time and without prior notice.
4. Cygnus does not guarantee the nonexistence of interruptions or errors in accessing the Site or its contents, or that it is updated. Cygnus will aim to resolve any issues, as long as there are no causes that make it impossible or difficult to execute, as soon as it becomes aware of errors, disconnections or lack of updating in the contents.
5. Access to the Site as well as the improper use that may be made of the information contained in it is the sole responsibility of the user. Cygnus shall not be liable for any consequence, damage or prejudice that may arise from such access or use. It is not responsible for any security errors that may occur or for damages that may be caused to the user's computer system (hardware and software) or to the files or documents stored therein, as a result of the presence of a virus in the user's computer that is used for the connection to the services and contents of the Site, a malfunction of the browser or the use of non-updated versions of the same.

Cygnus does not assume any responsibility derived from external contents linked to within the Site, nor does it guarantee the absence of viruses or other elements in them that may cause alterations in the computer system (hardware and software), in documents or files of the user, including any liability for damages of any kind caused to the user for this reason.   - Activities or contents that endanger the protection of public health, respect for the dignity of the person and the principle of non-discrimination, and the protection of health and children.

You may report this to Cygnus for the purposes of the provisions of the LSSICE.

7. The unauthorized use of the information contained in the Site, its resale, as well as the infringement of the intellectual property rights of Cygnus will give rise to legally established responsibilities.
8. Any third party link to the Site should be linked to its main page, being prohibited "deep links", "framing" and any other use of the contents of the Site, in favor of unauthorised third parties.

9. "Cookies" policy. Cygnus may use own and third party cookies when a user browses the web. "Cookies" are files that are downloaded to your computer when you access certain web pages. Cookies allow a website, among other things, to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or his or her computer and, depending on the information they contain and how they use their equipment, can be used to recognise the user. In this sense, the Site uses its own cookies on the acceptance of the cookies policy and to maintain the user's session, as well as the Google Analytics cookie that recognises the number of visits, pages or sections visited, time navigation, sites visited before entering this page, details about the browsers used and information related to the navigation itself.
